1. In the present petition, the grievance being raised by the petitioner is that petitioner has been wrongly transferred from Narnaul to Yamuna Nagar vide impugned order dated 08.11.2013, copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-3 whereas the petitioner could have been accommodated at a nearby station where the posts are still lying vacant.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the respondents be directed to consider the said request of the petitioner, which has already been raised in the representation dated 15.11.2023 copy of which has been appended as (Annexure P-5) and to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.
3. Notice of motion.
4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant

Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on

behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, the representation dated 15.11.2023 (Annexure P-5) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order and in case, after the decision, the petitioner is found entitled for any benefit, the same will be extended to him within a further period of four weeks, otherwise due reasons for not accepting the claim will be mentioned in the speaking order for the information and necessary action for the petitioner.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

6. Ordered accordingly.
