The instant writ petition has been filed for seeking a direction to respondents No.2 and 4 to confiscate and take possession of the essential commodity from the premises of the petitioners. A further prayer has been made for issuance of direction to the respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 28.11.2023 (Annexure P-4).

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the respondent No.2-District Collector, Hisar, to decide the representation dated

28.11.2023 (Annexure P-4) sent by the petitioner by passing a speaking and reasoned order in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Vivek Saini, Addl. A.G. Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and he has no objection to the aforesaid prayer being granted.

Accordingly, with the consent of the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- District Collector, Hisar, to consider the representation dated 28.11.2023 (Annexure P-4) filed by the petitioner and to pass a speaking and reasoned order thereupon in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order after granting an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
