The two petitioners are stated to be residing in live-in relationship. They feel threat to their life and liberty from private respondent No.4 and so have prayed for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus to the official respondents to protect their life and liberty.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sahil R. Bakshi, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent- State.

Perusal of the petition would reveal that petitioner No.2 – Ajaypal Singh is already married with respondent No.4, though no issue was born out of this marriage. Though it is stated that petitioner No.2 has already filed a divorce petition against respondent No.4 which is pending in the District Court, Amritsar but it is conceded by learned counsel that no decree of divorce has been filed so far, so as to dissolve the marriage of petitioner No.2 with respondent No.4.

Apart from above, the contention raised by the petitioner is that as respondent No.4 came to know about the fact that petitioner No.2 is residing with petitioner No.1, she had started giving threat to petitioner No.2 of his implication

in the false case due to which petitioners feel threatened that they may be caused harm.

After hearing learned counsel, this Court is not inclined to issue any direction. Simply because respondent No.4, who is the wife of petitioner No.2 is protesting against illicit relations of the petitioner, cannot be a reason to issue any direction as sought by the petitioners. As it appears that this petition has been filed just to receive a stamp of this Court to the illicit, immoral and illegal relationship of the petitioners, without there being any real threat to their life and liberty. As such, the present petition is dismissed.
