The petitioners seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in a case bearing FIR No.0031 dated 13.02.2024 under Sections 420, 384, 388, 389, 506 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Balongi, District SAS Nagar (Mohali).

The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the interim orders dated 01.04.2024 and 26.04.2024 (passed in CRM-M-12726-2024) passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation in terms of the orders dated 01.04.2024 and 26.04.2024 (passed in CRM-M-12726-2024) and are not

required for custodial interrogation.

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In view of the above, the interim order dated 01.04.2024 is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
