This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant the benefit of 1st ACP to the petitioner after completion of 10 years service (01.03.2012) as per ACP Rules with all consequential benefits.
