Status report by way of affidavit of Shri Manpreet Singh, Superintendent of Police (Rural), District SAS Nagar (Mohali) has been filed on behalf of respondent – State. Para No.7 of the said report is relevant, which reads as under:-

“That vide the present petition, the petition has prayed for issuance of writ of mandamus directing the respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner a the hands of respondent No.3.

In response to the same, it is submitted that no threat has been assessed to the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondent No.3 at this stage as alleged. The representation of the petitioner has been duly enquiry into and finding no action required on the same in view of the statement suffered by the petitioner, the same stands filed/closed. The deponent assures this Hon’ble Court the protection of life and liberty of the petitioner shall be ensured. ”

In view of the aforesaid report, when no threat perception has been found to the life and liberty of the petitioner, no direction is required.

Disposed of.

However, petitioner will be at liberty to avail alternative remedy as available to him in accordance with law.
