The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in a case bearing FIR No.31 dated 13.02.2024 under Sections 420, 384, 388, 389, 506 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Balongi, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim orders dated 01.04.2024 and 26.04.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the orders dated 01.04.2024 and 26.04.2024 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 01.04.2024 is made absolute.

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However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and she shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
