The present petition has been filed seeking quashing of FIR No.12 dated 16.01.2022, under Sections 323, 324, 452, 148 and 149 of IPC, registered at Police Station Rama Mandi, Jalandhar, on the basis of compromise deed dated 26.03.2022 (Annexure P-2), and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.
