1. The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C. with a prayer to grant interim regular bail for a period of 10 days in case FIR No.203 dated 14.11.2022 registered under Sections 15-C, 25 and 27 of of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station Bhikhi, District Mansa.
2. Learned counsel for the petitoiner contends that the marriage of cousin of the petitioner is fixed on 16th March, 2024 at Manav Resort, Malerkotla and has relied upon the marriage card, in this regard. He further contends that the father of the petitoiner had died two years ago and his parental uncle used to take care of his parents and family.
3. I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the record.

4. In fact, the marriage of Amandeep Kaur is scheduled to be held on 16.03.2024 whereas the application for grant of interim regular bail has come up for hearing today and it is impossible for the State of Punjab to verify the facts. Moreover, in the impugned order dated 20.02.2024 (Annexure P-3) passed by the Court of Special Judge, Mansa, it has been observed that the scheduled marriage is not of any family member and the parents of Amandeep Kaur are still alive and they can make the necessary arrangements for the various ceremonies.
5. In view of the above, there is no ground to allow the present application and the same is accordingly dismissed.
