1. In the present writ petition, the grievance being raised by the petitioner is that the transfer policy which has been envisaged for the department concerned be not given effect to.

2. As per the interim order passed, though, the petitioner was directed to participate on online transfer policy but any order passed will not be given effect to.

3. Learned counsel for the respondents, on the instructions from Mr. Sandeep Kumar, Warder, O/o D.G. Prisons, Panchkula, Haryana, submits that no transfer policy for the Department in question has been given effect to as of now and appropriate decision will only be taken in the general transfer which will be scheduled to be held in the year 2025 and in case, the petitioner has any grievance at the relevant stage, she can avail

appropriate remedy.

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4. Keeping in view the fact that no transfer policy has been given effect to as of now, no order is required to be passed in the present petition but liberty is given that in case any transfer policy is being impact to by the respondents henceforth and the petitioner is aggrieved, she can avail appropriate remedy.

5. The present writ petition is disposed of in above terms.
