1. The petitioner-Gram Panchayat has approached this Court for seeking construction of an under-pass in front of the ***Pakka Pull Pir Dargah*** under the fly-over which is being constructed on the GT Road i.e. NH-44 Karnal.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that at this stage he would confine his prayer only to the extent that a decision should be taken by the respondent-NHAI as regards the feasibility of acceding to the demand raised by the petitioner-Gram Panchayat.
3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent-NHAI refers to the photographs appended with the present writ petition and points

out that two under-passes are already proposed by the NHAI. He however has no objection to the submission of a representation and consideration of the same as regards the technical feasibility of the request made by the petitioner-Gram Panchayat.

4. The present writ petition is accordingly **disposed of** at this stage without commenting on the merits of the case and with the consent of the parties granting liberty to the petitioner-Gram Panchayat to submit a representation to the Project Director along with their demand. In the event of any such application being submitted, the Project Director (NHAI) shall examine the feasibility of acceding to such demand and take a considerate decision thereupon.
