1. Present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the order dated 02.12.2020 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Deputy Commissioner-cum-District Magistrate, Sangrur whereby it has been ordered to Tehsildar (Dhuri) to reinstate/restore the possession of the respondent No. 1 qua her share in the house.

2. On 19.04.2022, a Coordinate Bench of this Court was pleased to issue notice of motion subject to deposit of an amount of Rs.25,000/- as litigation expenses.

3. On 03.05.2023, a Coordinate Bench has passed the following order:-
