After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondents to confirm him as driver in the Minister Car Section, Haryana keeping in view the work which the petitioner had already performed in the said section.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana, who is appearing on behalf of the respondents keeping in view the advance copy served, submits that in case any request is received from the petitioner raising such claim, an appropriate order will be passed, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of this case, which will be brought to the notice of the department, within a period of 08 weeks from the receipt of any such claim and in case it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same

will be extended to him otherwise, due reasons for not accepting the claim of the petitioner will be given in the speaking order so passed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for.
