VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. Present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ directing the respondents to reimburse the medical bill of Rs.25,020/- alongwith 9% interest to the petitioner as the same has been admittedly reimbursed by the respondents in the wrong account due to the mistake on the part of DDO.
2. Learned State counsel has filed short reply by way of affidavit on behalf of respondent Nos. 1, 3 and 5 today in the Court, the same is taken on record, and has submitted that the amount has now been credited to the right account and thus, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
3. None has appeared on behalf of the petitioner to rebut the said aspect.
4. In view of the above facts and circumstances, present Civil Writ Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous at this stage, with liberty to the petitioner to move an application for revival of the present case, in case, any cause of action survives in the same.
