1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 09.11.2023 passed in CWP-25304-2023.
2. Short reply by way of affidavit of Sanjay Rawal, General Manager, Haryana Roadways, Yamunanagar, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondents submits that the order dated 09.11.2023 passed in CWP-25304-2023 has since been complied with and representation of the petitioner has been decided by passing a speaking order dated 22.03.2024 (Annexure R-1).
4. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.

6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
