



alleged that the petitioner had been defaming him by uploading morphed photographs of the complainant and of his wife.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that it is a case where the petitioner has strained relationship with her husband namely Lucky Bajaj, against whom the petitioner had lodged FIR under Section 498-A IPC, who infact is a computer professional and is running a business relating to computer and being proficient in computers has tried to malign the petitioner. It has further been submitted that none of the 4 mobile phones, which were used for accessing the ‘Instagram ID’ through which the photographs were allegedly uploaded was being used by the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has pointed out the details of the said mobile phones as incorporated in the order of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Faridkot, which are reproduced hereinunder:

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to her furnishing personal bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”



- 3. Learned State counsel upon instructions has informed that pursuant to interim directions issued by this Court, the petitioner has since joined investigation and is not required for any custodial interrogation.
- 4. Having regard to the aforestated position, wherein the petitioner is stated to have joined investigation and is not required for any custodial interrogation, the petition is accepted and the interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 14.03.2024 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
