Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the question of law raised in the present petition has already been decided by this Court while passing order in CWP No. 10238 of 2017 titled as ***Jeewan Lata Vs. State of Punjab and others***, decided on 10.05.2019, hence the present petition be also disposed of in the same terms.

Learned counsel for the respondents has not been able to differentiate the judgment in ***Jeewan Lata's case (supra)*** as per the facts in the present case. The petitioner in the present case is also a part time employee, who has worked for more than three decades and is claiming regularization and applicability of Old Pension Scheme.
