NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ of certiorari for quashing the order dated 12.04.2022 (Annexure P-3) passed by respondent No.4, whereby the claim of the petitioner to release his pending pensionary benefits along with interest has been rejected and further sought a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to release the pending pensionary benefits of the petitioner along with interest @ 9% per annum and to release the arrears of re-fixation of pay i.e. Rs.8,67,153/- for the period from 01.01.2006 to 01.12.2020.
2. Learned counsel for respondent No.4 submits that the matter has been examined by the Executive Officer, Nagar Panchayat, Moonak, District Sangrur and it has been resolved that the total due amount of Rs.7,27,353/- shall be paid to the petitioner in six equal

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monthly installments.

3. In view of the above statement, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition.

4. Dismissed as not pressed.
