1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 17.11.2023 passed in CWP-16475-2015.

2. Counsel for the respondents has produced copy of order dated 21.05.2024 passed in LPA-1265-2024, whereby the Division Bench has stayed the order passed by the Writ Court, though issuing some fresh directions.

3. Since the present petition is filed only qua the compliance of the order of Writ Court, which has been stayed by the Division Bench, therefore, this Court does not find any ground to proceed further in the present petition.

4. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.

5. However, the petitioners would be at liberty to file a fresh petition qua compliance of the fresh directions, if any, issued by the



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Division Bench or qua the order passed by the Writ Court in case the ultimate result of the LPA goes in their favour.
