1. This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.519 dated 09.10.2013 under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Sector 5, Panchkula.

2. On 10.07.2014, the following order was passed:-

“The present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 519 dated 9.10.2013 registered under Sections 420/467/468/471 IPC registered at Police Station Sector 5, Panchkula as the petitioner was allotted more than one plot.

The issue of double allotment is under consideration



before this Court and Advocate General, Haryana has given an undertaking in that matter that no coercive method will be adopted in such like cases.

In view of the undertaking given by Advocate General, Haryana, no separate order is required to be passed in this Court.
