It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that similar situated person earlier approached this Court by way of filing CWP-1055-2024, wherein, direction has been given and in pursuance to the direction given, now the work has commenced. He submits that the petitioners are the senior citizens, however, no action has been taken till date on representation filed by them. He has drawn the attention of this Court to the photographs appended with the petition.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Upasna Dhawan, AAG, Haryana appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and has stated that for the redressal of their grievance, the petitioners should file a fresh representation before respondent No.5.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioners be granted liberty to file a fresh representation before respondent No.5 i.e. the Junior Engineer, Ward No.22, Municipal Corporation, Yamunanagar and he be directed to decide the same after hearing the petitioner in a time bound manner.

After hearing both the parties and perusing the record, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to file their appropriate representation before respondent No.5 as prayed for within a period of one week from today. If any such representation is filed by the petitioners within the stipulated period, then respondent No.5 i.e. the Junior Engineer, Ward No.22, Municipal Corporation, Yamunanagar is directed to hear the petitioners and decide the same in accordance with law within a period of two weeks from the date of its filing keeping in view the directions already passed by this Court in CWP-1055-2024.
