1. The petitioner is seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect his life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5, who are threatening the petitioner to falsely implicate him in serious offences.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners inter alia contends that respondent No.5 has been extending threats of dire consequences to the petitioner at the behest of respondent No.4, who is his sister in law on account of some family dispute. She submits that an application/representation dated 26.02.2024 (Annexure P-4) was given to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala, however, in vain. Learned counsel submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions could be issued to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala to look into representation dated 26.02.2024 (Annexure P-4) and take appropriate steps at the earliest.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On asking of the Court, Mr. Navdeep Singh, DAG, Punjabs

accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

5. In view of the restricted prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala to look into the representation dated 26.02.2024 (Annexure P-4) and take appropriate steps, if any, required, in accordance with law.
