The petitioners seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.495 dated 07.10.2023 registered under Sections 406 and 420 IPC at Police Station City Bhiwani, District Bhiwani.

The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the order dated 14.03.2024, the petitioners have joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 14.03.2024 is made absolute. However, the petitioners shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
