As agreed, (statements of learned counsel for the appellants as well as counsel for the Insurance Company, separately recorded) a sum of Rs.4,00,000/- (Rupees Four Lakhs Only) over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants in full and final settlement of the claim. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount will be paid to the appellants as per MACT award.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit crossed cheques in the sum of Rs.4,00,000/- (Rupees Four Lakhs Only) in the respective names of all the appellants in the same proportion as awarded by MACT, before the MACT Court, Bathinda on or before 12.06.2024, failing which the amount will carry 9% interest per annum from the date of this order till the cheques are deposited before the MACT Court, Bathinda. After depositing the cheques by the Insurance Company before the MACT Court, Bathinda, MACT Court Bathinda will intimate to the appellants to collect the cheques.

Appeal stands disposed of.
