1. Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the order dated 06.11.2020 (Annexure P-4) vide which respondent No.2 had dismissed the petitioner's application filed under Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007.
2. Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for private respondent No.4 have submitted that the impugned order is appealable.
3. None had appeared on behalf of the petitioner on 09.08.2022 and 25.04.2023. Today, nobody has appeared on behalf of the petitioner although the matter has been called twice.
4. Dismissed for non-prosecution.
5. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to move an application for restoration of the present petition or to file a fresh petition in case any cause survives.
