1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No. 91 dated 10.09.2008 under Sections 376, 417 of Indian Penal Code and Section 67 of Information and Technology Act lodged at Police Station Sudhar, District Ludhiana (Annexure P-2) and further proceedings taken thereon.
2. Learned State counsel has brought to the notice of this Court that vide order dated 22.03.2023 passed in CRM-M-20107-2019 impugned order dated 30.10.2018 declaring the petitioner as proclaimed offender, was set aside and he was directed to appear before the learned trial Court on 28.04.2023. Learned State counsel further submits that the petitioner till date has not submitted himself to the process of law and has not complied with the aforementioned directions issued by this Court.



4. Faced with the same, learned Sr. Advocate for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition and seeks liberty to file a fresh petition after the petitioner submits himself to the process of law.
5. In view of the above, present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
