1. This Court notices that since 20.10.2022, no one has put in appearance in this case in spite of the fact the case was listed twice before this Court. This Court further notices that on 21.03.2006, while admitting the Writ Petition, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Admit.

We have heard learned counsel for the parties on the question of interim order. Having considered the matter in the light of the guide-lines issued by respondent No.3 on 30.11.10025, particularly paragraph C of the said guide-lines, we direct that four containers in question shall be released to the petitioner, subject to petitioner's depositing 50% of the demurrage charges for 75 days per container in cash and on furnishing bank guarantee for the balance amount to the satisfaction of General Manager of respondent No.3. The petitioner shall keep the bank guarantee alive till



the disposal of the writ petition. If any goods are found to be lying in the containers, the same shall be de-stuffed and dealt with in accordance with law.”

2. Keeping in view the order passed as above by this Court, nothing further is required to be adjudicated and therefore, we **dispose of** the present Writ Petition, making the said order dated 21.03.2006 absolute.

3. All pending applications filed in this case shall stand disposed of accordingly.
