1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking regular bail in case FIR No.406 dated 12.10.2023, under Sections 3, 4, 5, 7 of Immoral Trafficking Act, 1956 and Section 370 of IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station City Thanesar, District Kurukshetra (Annexure P-1).
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. The FIR was registered on the basis of information having been received from the office of the Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra, with the allegations of racket of prostitution going on in Hotel Hum-Tum, now named as Deluxe Hotel. It is further contended that the petitioner is in custody since 07.11.2023. The co-accused of the petitioner namely Vijay Kumar has been granted regular bail by this Court vide order dated 07.05.2024.
3. Learned State counsel has filed custody certificate of the petitioner dated 08.05.2024, which is taken on record. As per the custody certificate, the

has further informed that after completion of investigation, challan has been presented against all the 04 co-accused, who are already on bail.

4. I have considered the aforesaid contentions and perused the paper book.
5. Investigation is complete and the final report under Section 173 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been presented before the trial Court. Conclusion of trial is likely to take some time. There is no apprehension of absconding the petitioner during the trial, as such, without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the above facts, the present petition is allowed.
6. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail, subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
7. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
