1. The present Civil Revision Petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the impugned order dated 08.02.2022 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Additional Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Gidderbaha in civil suit No. 241 of 2021 whereby the application under Order 6 Rule 17 read with Section 151 CPC filed by the plaintiff/respondent has been allowed.
2. It has been brought to the notice of this Court that the main suit itself has been compromised and it has been stated that the plaintiff does not wish to carry on with the main suit and thus, the main suit has been dismissed as withdrawn as is apparent from the order dated 11.02.2023 and thus, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
