1. The present Civil Revision Petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the order dated 01.02.2021 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Additional District Judge (Appellate Authority), Ambala.

It has been brought to the notice of this Court that the tenant has made a statement before the Daily Lok Adalat that a compromise has been effected with the respondents and he has handed over the possession of the shop in question to the respondents and the rent appeal itself has been withdrawn vide order dated 11.11.2022 and thus, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
