VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari to set aside the Notification dated 22.03.2022 (Annexure P-4).

2. On 18.04.2022, a Coordinate Bench of this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the respondents submits that higher examination fee is being charged from the students of unaided self financing Colleges as they are charging a higher fee. The decision to charge a higher fee has been approved by a Committee constituted by the Vice Chancellor in its meeting dated 05.07.2021 and the said decision has been approved by the Executive Council in its meeting held on 08.12.2021.



Neither of these resolutions are under challenge and, thus, the writ petition deserves to be dismissed.

Learned counsel for the respondents is directed to file a detailed reply.

Adjourned to 05.07.2022.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the same, he seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh petition if so need be after laying down challenge to the decision dated 05.07.2021 and 08.12.2021.
4. In view of the above, the present Civil Writ Petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
5. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
