The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to consider and appoint the petitioner on the post of Driver/Peon in the Punjab State Cooperative Bank - Respondent No.4, keeping in view the letter dated 25.11.1997 (Annexure P-2) and the Judgement dated 28.09.1999 (Annexure P-4) with further prayer to keep reserve a post of Peon for the petitioner, as advertised vide advertisement (Annexure P-6), during pendency of instant petition.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite his best efforts, he has not been able to contact the petitioner and, therefore, he is having no further instructions in the matter.

In this view of the matter, the instant petition is hereby dismissed for non-prosecution, however, liberty is granted to the petitioner to revive the present petition, in case, any cause still survives.
