1. Present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ, order or direction for directing the respondents to pay the interest at the rate of 24% per annum upon delayed payment of retirement benefits and other dues of the petitioner.
2. Learned State counsel has submitted that the matter is of the year 1998 and in all probability, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.
3. None has appeared on behalf of the petitioner to rebut the said aspect inspite of the report of the registry that the counsel for the petitioner has been informed.

4. In view of the above, the present Civil Writ Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to move an application for restoration of the present case or to file a fresh petition, in case, any cause survives to him.
5. Pending miscellaneous application, if any, shall stand disposed of with the abovesaid order.
