1. As per office report, notice could not be served upon the respondent due to non-filing of process fee by the petitioner. From the case file, it is abundantly clear that despite elapse of more than 3 years now, the petitioner has not made any attempt even to deposit the process fee for effecting the service upon the respondent, after issuing notice of motion on 19.03.2020 with interim relief granted by this Court to the effect that “passing of the final order by the trial Court shall remain stayed”.
2. Looking into the proceedings and the conduct of the petitioner, who is consistently not appearing before this Court and has so far not even bothered to deposit the process fee for effecting service upon the respondent, this Court is duly convinced that the petitioner is not interested to pursue the present petition. Hence, the same is dismissed for want of prosecution. As far as the interim order is concerned, the same stands automatically vacated and trial Court shall proceed further in the matter in accordance with law.
