Learned State counsel has filed reply dated 16.03.2024 by way of an affidavit of Pawan Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, City, District Rewari on behalf of respondent Nos.5 and 6, which is taken on record and submits that present petition is totally misconceived as the petitioner has been detained, after passing of a detention order, wherein, respondent No.2 has recommended the detention, as per provisions of Section 3 of Prevention of Illicit Traffic in Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1988 with an objective to prevent the detainee from indulging in illicit trafficking of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances. As such, the order passed by the

competent authority is also attached with the reply as Annexure R-1. Copy of the same has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to challenge the order dated 31.10.2023.
4. Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as prayed for.
