Prayer made in the present writ petition is for directing the respondents to release the electricity connection in favour of the petitioner-School.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is a School and is aggrieved on account of non-release of the electricity

connection to the school premises by the respondent-Distribution Licensee. He contends that the petitioner is ready and willing to deposit all the necessary dues/statutory charges as are applicable, however, the request of the petitioner is not being considered and conceded to.

Learned counsel appearing for the respondent-Distribution Licensee contends that the respondent Distribution Licensee has no objection to the release of the electricity connection to the petitioner subject to petitioner submitting an application as per procedure and fulfilling all the obligations as prescribed under law.

In view of the aforesaid statement made on behalf of the respondent Distribution Licensee, the present writ petition is disposed of as not pressed at this stage.

Needless to mention here that in the event of the petitioner approaching the respondent Distribution Licensee and submitting an application along with all the required documents and subject to payment of all statutory dues as per applicable rules and regulations, the respondent Distribution Licensee shall remain bound by the statement to release the electricity connection in a time bound manner.
