1. The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India seeking writ of certiorari for quashing the impugned order dated 01.03.2001 (Annexure P-4) passed by respondent No.4 and further issue a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents to exempt the petitioners to pass the departmental test.
