VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. The present Civil Revision Petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the impugned order dated 23.01.2023 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Additional Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Kharar vide which the application under Order 7 Rule 11 CPC read with Section 151 CPC has been dismissed.

2. Learned Senior counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the main case is fixed for 16.12.2024 and has prayed that since, the matter has been compromised, the petitioner seeks to withdraw the main petition, and thus, the main case be pre-poned from 16.12.2024 to today.

3. Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances as well as the fact that the application for withdrawal is duly supported by an affidavit, the main case is pre-poned from 16.12.2024 to today itself and the application bearing CM-19154-CII-2024 is allowed and the petitioner is permitted to withdraw the present revision petition in view of the compromise dated 05.10.2024 (Annexure A-1).

4. In view of the above, present Civil Revision Petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
