1. The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Section 482 Cr.P.C., for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to not side with the private respondents on account of extraneous and illegal reasons and to decide the complaint on merits without any bias.
2. Mr. Rajiv Verma, DAG Punjab, having served with an advance copy of the petition on instructions from ASI Umesh Kumar informs the Court that the matter is under consideration and has been sent to the higher authorities i.e., Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana for further examination.

In the light of above factual aspects and circumstances, wherein the dispute pertains to matrimonial discord between husband and wife, this petition seems to have been filed in haste without waiting outcome of the complaint/representation made by the petitioner, which is pending for final adjudication before the competent authorities, hence the same being devoid of merits and premature stands dismissed with no order as to costs.
