1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 10 read with Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 25.01.2024 passed in CWP-1621-2024.
2. Compliance report dated 31.07.2024 by way of affidavit respondent No.1, filed in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
3. Counsel for the respondents submits that the order dated 25.01.2024 passed in CWP-1621-2024 has since been complied with and possession of the land has been restored.
4. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
