By way of filing the instant petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has approached this Court for issuance of writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the official respondents to conduct election of the Board of Directors of respondent no.4 (PUNCOFED), whose term has been elapsed on 02.09.2017 and for writ of certiorari for quashing the order dated 01.03.2021 (Annexure P/4).

Learned counsel for the respondent nos.3 and 4 submits that during the pendency of present petition, the appeal against the order of punishment dated 27.10.2020 (Annexure P-1) has already been dismissed vide order dated 28.07.2021 against which Revision Petition No.14 of 2022 was preferred by the petitioner, which has been partly allowed vide order dated 26.07.2023 and the order of punishment dated 27.10.2020 has been modified to the extent that instead of reverting the petitioner to a lower post of Clerk on initial pay scale, her two annual increments have been ordered to be stopped without cumulative effect. He further submits that since the appeal has already been decided, therefore, the present petition has become infructuous.

Disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
