Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for directing respondent Nos.2 & 3 to ensure that no multiple enquiries are conducted in the case arising out of FIR No.124 dated 19.06.2020 (P-1), under Sections 325, 506 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Division No.7, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana.
