1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners, in case FIR No.199 dated 02.12.2023, registered under Sections 452, 323, 148 and 149 IPC, at Police Station Jhunir, District Mansa, Punjab.
