1. The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to assign the duty of the petitioner from field area (hard duty) to the lighter duty in the offices of SE/Circle Office, XEN/Op. Divn., Sub-Divisional Officer/Store, Sub-Divisional Officer/TRW, Power Houses keeping in view the 73% Locomotor Disability in accordance with the Right of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 so that the petitioner can easily do his job.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner had filed a representation dated 04.08.2023 (Annexure P-4) to respondent No.2- Managing Director, DHBVNL, Hisar but the same has not been considered and decided till date. He further submitted that at this stage, the petitioner will be

satisfied in case the aforesaid representation dated 04.08.2023 (Annexure P-4) is considered and decided by respondent No.2-Managing Director, DHBVNL, Hisar, in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.
4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Samarth Sagar, Addl. A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of all the respondents. He submitted that in view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, he has no objection in case time bound direction is issued in this regard.
5. In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, without calling for the reply from the respondents and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Managing Director, DHBVNL, Hisar to consider and decide the representation dated 04.08.2023 (Annexure P-4) strictly in accordance with law and within a period of three months from today.
