CRM-16554-2024

1. Application is allowed as prayed for, subject to all just exceptions. Annexures P-9 to P-11 are taken on record.

CRM-16555-2024

1. The present application has been moved under Section 482 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to implead the injured namely (i) Somnath as respondent No.3, (ii) Karanpal as respondent No.4 (iii) Bhushan @ Krishan as respondent No.5 in the main petition.

2. Notice of the application to the non-applicant/respondents.

3. Ms. Sheenu Sura, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of non-applicant/respondent-State and Mr. Deep Singh Saini, Advocate for non-applicant-respondent No.2 and they have no objection in case, the injured, namely, Somnath, Karanpal and Bhushan @ Krishan are impleaded as respondents No.3 to 5.

4. For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed and the aforesaid injured are ordered to be impleaded as respondents No.3 to

5 in the present petition. The Registry is directed to carry out the necessary correction in the memo of parties.

CRM-16556-2024

1. The petitioner has filed the present application under Section 482 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to issue direction to the trial Court to record the statements of injured/respondents qua the compromise effected between the parties for quashing of the FIR in question.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioners does not wish to press the present application, at this stage.

3. Dismissed as not pressed, at this stage.

CRM-M-13530-2024

1. The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.263 dated 07.08.2019 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 341, 506 of IPC, at Police Station Naraingarh, District Ambala (Annexure P-1) and subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 03.03.2024 (Annexure P-2).

2. Vide order dated 15.03.2024, this Court had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Magistrate for getting their statements recorded with respect to the compromise dated 03.03.2024 (Annexure P-2).

3. Pursuant to aforesaid order, the parties have appeared before the Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate-cum-Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Naraingarh and got their statements recorded. Report dated 19.04.2024 has been received whereby after recording the statements of the parties, the Court below has shown its satisfaction that the compromise is genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.

4. I have heard counsel for the parties and gone through the case file.

5. In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court below and also in view of the affidavits filed by injured/respondents No.3 to 5, whereby they have stated that they have no objection in case the FIR is quashed on the basis of the compromise. Thus, considering the offence for which the accused have been charged are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out the differences for betterment of future life of the parties and also in view of the law laid down in **Gian Singh Vs. State of**

Punjab and another, 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab 2007(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the present petition for quashing the FIR is allowed qua the petitioners.

6. Resultantly, FIR No.263 dated 07.08.2019 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 341, 506 of IPC, at Police Station Naraingarh, District Ambala (Annexure P-1) and subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 03.03.2024 (Annexure P-2) are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
