SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (ORAL)

1. The instant petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India *inter alia* for issuance of a writ of certiorari quashing impugned order, dated 03.08.2023, Annxure P-6, passed by respondent No.3. Another prayer has been made for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.3 to decide the application for vacation of stay, Annexure P-7, filed by the petitioner.
2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that by order dated 27.06.2023, Annexure P-4, petitioner has been reinstated with a warning and punishment of stoppage of three annual increments with cumulative effect has been imposed. She submits that this order has been challenged by the Society-respondent No.5 by filing an appeal under Section 114 of the Haryana

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Societies Act, 1984, which is pending and order Annexure P-4 has been stayed vide impugned order, Annexure P-6. She submits that petitioner has filed an application Annexure P-7 for the vacation of the interim order, which is not being decided.

- 4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Aman Bahri, Addl. A.G. Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of official respondents No.1 to 4.
- 5. Mr.Dharampal Chhachhia, Advocate has put in appearance and filed his Power of Attorney on behalf of respondents No. 5 and 6, which is taken on record.
- 6. Pursuant to the previous order, State counsel has received instructions and has apprised the Court that a new incumbent has joined the post of Deputy Registrar and appeal has been fixed for hearing on 23.04.2024.
- 7. As the appeal is pending before the appellate authority for the last more than six months, writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to finally decide the appeal after hearing the parties as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of 6 months from the date of communication of copy of this order.
