1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 22.11.2023 passed in CWP-26161-2023.
2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 22.11.2023 passed in CWP-26161-2023, demarcation has been conducted and, therefore, the present petition has become infructuous.
3. Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
4. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
