SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (ORAL)

1. By way of present revision petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has approached this Court for modification of order dated 31.08.2023, Annexure P1, passed by learned Additional District Judge, Amritsar whereby application, Annexure P5, filed by the petitioner has been partly rejected.

2. At the outset counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is not aggrieved with the declining of future interest by the Executing Court. He submits that the amount deposited by the respondents was required to be appropriated first towards interest and then towards

principal. He submits that interest was payable on the balance amount. He contends that this aspect has not been considered by the Executing Court. He has clear instructions to state that petitioner is not claiming interest on the deposited amount after 21.12.2015.

3. At this stage, counsel for the petitioner seeks and is granted permission to withdraw the present revision petition with liberty to move an appropriate application before the Executing Court raising this issue.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to move appropriate application regarding appropriation of the amount deposited and for payment of interest on the balance amount, if any.
