1. The prayer made in the present writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents for uniformly implementation of the amendment notification dated 08.07.1995 of Class-III, School Cadre Rules, 1978, by treating them as one of the category of Lecturers as mentioned in Appendix 'B'.

2. Learned State counsel while referring to para No.5 of the short affidavit of Gian Singh, Dy. Director (Vocational), office of Director of Public Instruction(S.E), Punjab, Chandigarh dated 30.01.2004, submits that present petition has been rendered infructuous. The above para reads thus:

“4.That all the incumbents who were appointed as vocational masters/mistresses prior to 08.07.1995 and had acquired higher qualification of post-graduation or degree in Engineering prior to 08.07.95 would be deemed to be vocational lecturers in terms of note below S.No.2 sub-category (J) of Appendix-B of notification dated 08.07.1995, and a pay scale of Rs.6400-10640 w.e.f. 01.01.1996 would be admissible to them.



“5.That the relief claimed by the petitioners is admissible and it has been extended to them. Hence this writ petition has become infructuous.”

3. Ordered accordingly.
