1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 04.08.2023 passed in CWP-11694-2023.
2. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 04.08.2023 passed in CWP-11694-2023 has since been complied with and the representation filed by the petitioner has been decided by passing the speaking order dated 22.05.2024. Copy of the aforesaid order dated 22.05.2024 produced by the counsel for the respondent in the Court today, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
